
Make your own yummy gummy double helix out of sweets and find out about the shape of DNA in the process!

You will use four colours of gummy sweet to represent the four kinds of DNA letters or 'bases' in DNA (usually known as A, C, G and T). Just like in DNA, one gummy will always tend to pair with one other. That means if you know the sequence of one strand, you can work out the sequence and build your other yummy gummy DNA strand.
